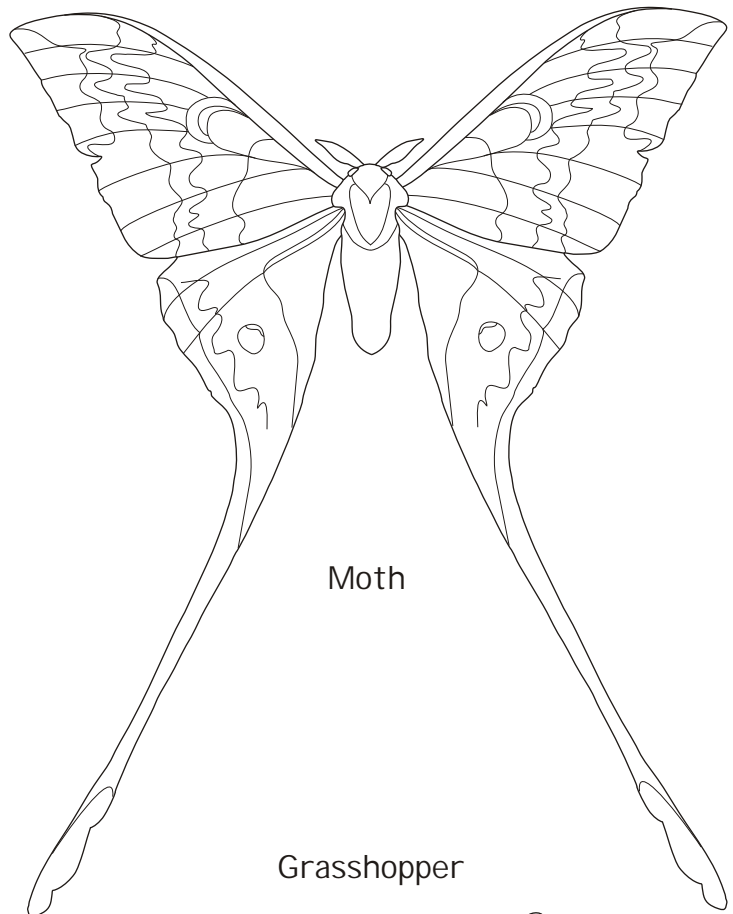


O.U.M.N.H. Brilliant Bugs!

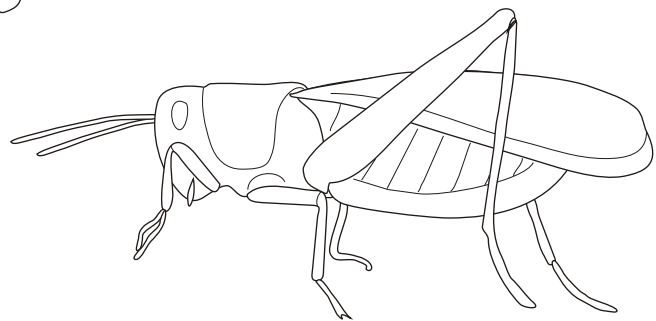
All insects have a body made of three parts: a head, a thorax, and an abdomen. They all have six legs, and most have wings.

Spiders have a body made up of two parts, and have eight legs.

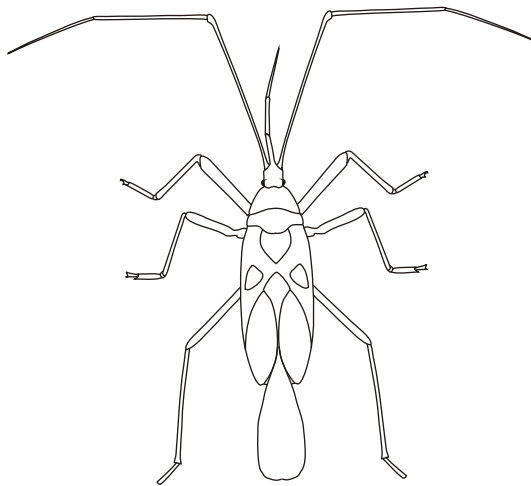

O.U.M.N.H. Fabulous Fossils!

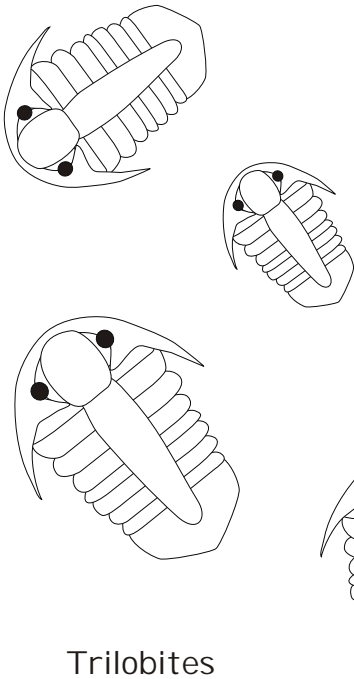
Fossils can tell us a lot about the animals that lived long ago, but they can't tell us one thing....

Nobody knows what colour they were!

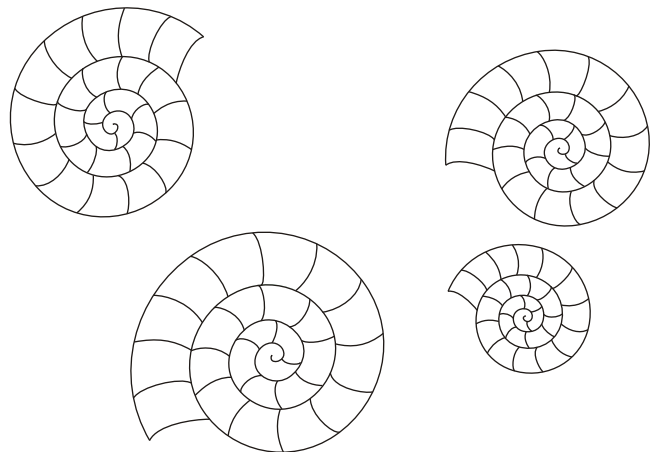

Minerals come in lots of different colours.

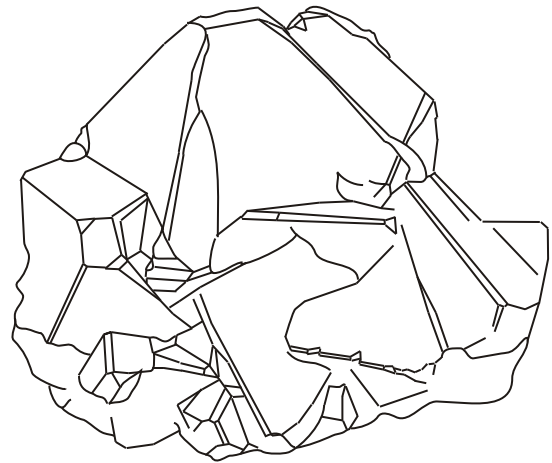

Pyrite = yellow

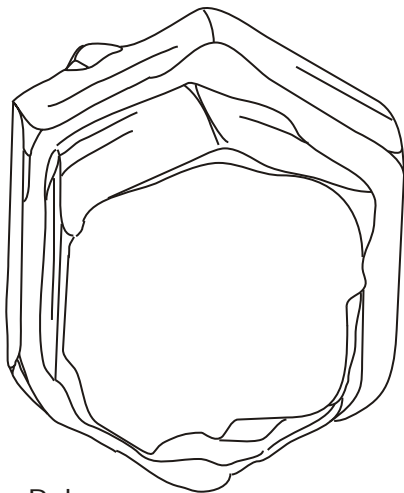
